

About Google Password Recovery Pro

Google Password Recovery Pro is all-in-one Enterprise software to help you **instantly** recover your lost or forgotten Google Passwords from top browsers on your system.

It automatically detects & decrypts passwords from secret password store of each supported browsers. Once recovered, it displays complete details including Browser, Google Login and Password. You can also generate detailed **backup report in HTML/CSV** format.

Also it can discover and help you remove all the stored passwords, thus **protecting your Google login passwords from being stolen by hackers, ransomware, password stealers etc.**



Benefits of Google Password Recovery Pro

Here are the main benefits for you,

- Instantly Recover Your stored Google Login Password
- **Recover Passwords from 15+ browsers** including Chrome, Firefox, IE, Opera & more
- Supports both 32-bit & 64-bit versions of Browsers
- Recover Password of any length & complexity
- Automatically finds & decrypts password from profile location of each browser
- Recover Password from All Profiles (for Firefox, Seamonkey etc)
- **Recover from Portable Browsers, Non-default Password locations, Profiles copied from another Laptop**
- **Remove Stored Password from Browsers to Protect from hackers, ransomware, password stealers etc**
- Generate Password Report in HTML/CSV format for backup/auditing purpose
- **Command-line version help you integrate it in your scripts/programs**
- Automate your Google Password Recovery operation daily or periodically
- Recover Firefox Passwords protected with Master Password
- Works on all Windows 32-bit & 64-bit starting from XP to Windows 10
- Standard Installer for easier installation & un-installation

Requirements

Google Password Recovery Pro works on both 32-bit & 64-bit platforms starting from Windows XP to **Windows 10**.

RAM: 4 GB+ Recommended


Operating System: Windows XP, Vista, Windows 2008/2012/2016, Windows 7/8/10.

Installation

Google Password Recovery Pro comes with standard windows installer which allows seamless installation & un-installation.

Launch the setup file and follow on-screen instructions to complete the installation as shown below,





You can un-install it from the **Control Panel** or click on **Uninstaller** from Installed location of Google Password Recovery Pro

Using GUI Version

Google Password Recovery Pro is very easy to use. After installation, just launch it. It will instantly recover and show all the stored Google login passwords from all the top browsers as shown below,

You can easily [sort the displayed password list](#) based on Browser type, Google Login, Password etc. by simply clicking on corresponding header in the List.

Also you can click on '**Recover Again**' button to refresh the list anytime.



Right Click Menu Options


Right click context menu help you to quickly & easily [copy various fields](#) (such as, Google Username, Password etc).

Also you can [launch Gmail website](#), [delete the password](#) from selected browser as shown below,



Google Password Removal Feature

This is one of the **unique & useful feature** of **Google Password Recovery Pro**. It helps you to easily remove one or more selected Google password from selected Browsers with just click of button as shown below,



If you have accidentally stored Google password on any laptop then you can discover and remove it instantly. This way you can **protect your important login passwords from being stolen by hackers, ransomware, virus, password stealers etc**


Current version supports removal of password from all browsers except Firefox, Seamonkey, Safari, Tor.

This feature is available only in Enterprise Edition.

Google Password Report Generation

Google Password Recovery Pro helps you to generate detailed report in both **HTML & CSV** format. Once passwords are recovered, simply click on Report button and then select the Type of Report (HTML or CSV) from the 'File Save Dialog'.

Here is the sample of HTML based Google Password Report,



Browser Settings

Browser Settings help you to tweak & customize Google Password Recovery operations as per you need.

Mainly it helps you to **specify custom profile paths** for each browser (see next section) and also specify the **Master Password for Firefox**.


Click on '**Settings**' button from the main GUI screen and you will see the 'Browser Settings' dialog as shown below,



Settings - Customize Browser Profile Path

This is one of the unique benefits of Google Password Recovery Pro. It helps you to specify the custom profile paths for each supported browser.

To set the custom profile path, click on Settings button in main GUI screen and you will see the Settings dialog as shown below,



This is useful in cases when you have set the Profile path in Browser to non-default location or when you are using Portable version of Browser. This is also useful when you have copied browser profile folder from another laptop for recovery process.

Here are simple steps to set or remove Custom Profile Path,

- First select the Browser by double click in the List or select from Combo box
- It will populate the current Custom Path (if any) in the Edit box
- Now to **ADD** new folder, click on Browse button or simply Drag & Drop your folder
- To **REMOVE** just set the Edit box empty
- Finally click on '**Update**' button to add/remove the custom path
- Once done, you will see new Custom Path is updated in the list for selected Browser


Now you can go back to main GUI screen, click on '**Recover Again**' button to recover the passwords from this new Custom Profile path.

Note that this feature is available only in Enterprise Edition.

Using Command-line Version

Google Password Recovery Pro supports both GUI & command-line in the single executable file. Command-line version helps you to fully automate Google password recovery operation. You can also easily [integrate it into your scripts or programs](#) as part of advanced operations.

Here is the screenshot of Command-line version (passwords masked for security reasons)

Here are various command-line options & examples

`GooglePasswordRecoveryPro.exe [report.html | report.csv]`

//Recover & Save the Google Password Report in HTML format (default)
`GooglePasswordRecoveryPro.exe report.html`

//Recover & Save the Google Password Report to CSV file locally
`GooglePasswordRecoveryPro.exe report.csv`

//Save the Google Password Report to selected folder
`GooglePasswordRecoveryPro.exe "c:\my reports\report.html"`

By default it will generate report in HTML format. You can specify CSV extension to Output File to generate report in CSV format.


Note that Command-line version is available only in Enterprise Edition.

Automation of Google Password Recovery


Google Password Recovery Pro Command-line version can help you **to completely automate your Google Password Recovery operations** daily or periodically. It can generate detailed report in CSV or HTML format which can be used for **future auditing or backup purposes**.

Here are simple steps to automate Google Password Recovery using **Windows Task Scheduler**.


1) Launch Windows Task Scheduler from Administrative Tools in Control Panel. Next click on "Create Basic Task" on right side panel as shown below,



2) On the Basic Task page, enter name as 'Google Password Recovery'. On next page select 'Daily or Weekly or Monthly' with appropriate Time settings as per your need.




3) Next on the 'Action' Page, click on Start Program and then enter command & arguments as shown below,



For more command-line options refer to Google Password Recovery Pro Command-line Version section.

4) Finally click on Finish button to schedule the automatic Google Password Recovery operation.
